Noise Control!

It's about that time to talk about controlling the amount of noise we emit through the thin walls of our townhomes, through the loud music of afternoon or late-night barbecues or get-togethers in our backyards, and the lingering chatter that goes on outside of our homes in the middle of the night.

The City of Smyrna does have a noise ordinance that is enforceable and enforced. During the Spring and Summer months (when we spend most of our time outside), we must take care to be considerate to our neighbors when hosting parties or after-parties, etc. If your neighbor is playing his/her music too loud, find a nice way to let him/her know. If your neighbor and his/her friends are carrying on with loud outdoor conversations after hours, let them know. If all else fails, please call the Smyrna Police; they will be glad to enforce the City of Smyrna noise ordinance and issue the proper citations or warnings.

Whatever you do, PLEASE do not call the Association at 1:00 A.M. in the morning with your complaint!



Trash Can Lids, A Curb-Appeal Basic!

Curb appeal starts at the curb.

In walking through the neighborhood, it is quite visible that many homes have really ugly, beat-up, and rusty trash lids. **This is an ugly problem that has a really easy and cheap fix.**

If your trash can lid is in decent shape but the color is fading, you can freshen it up! Just go to The Home Depot or Lowes and buy green spray paint TO MATCH! Make sure the get the Rust-OLeum spray paint; it has a protective film that keeps the rust away for longer.

If your trash can lid is just beat-up and worn out, you will need to get a new one. New underground trash liners and lids can be obtained by calling City Sanitation at **770-431-2850**. The City will deliver your new item and charge it to your water bill. **Lids cost approximately \$10** and liners costs \$13.

Just imagine, for about \$10 dollars or so, you can add some much needed curb appeal to your home and join the fight to increase property values in Afton Downs!
