"Why?" you may ask. Because it is important that we adhere to Afton Downs' color palettes and keep some from painting the body of their homes neon green, fuchsia or other inappropriate colors. Our neighborhood's visual style is built from colors, imagery, layout and design, all of which help create a distinctive Afton Downs style. By employing the approved color schemes, we create a uniformed community-look that helps differentiate Afton Downs from other townhome subdivisions in Smyrna.

And, if you would like to paint your house, trim or fascia with a color that is not approved by the board, give us a call or e-mail us – **we'll be glad to work on a compromise with you**. The ACC's ultimate goal is for every home in Afton Dows to have a clean and neat appearance while maintaining the integrity of the neighborhood's style. This, we are certain, will keep our property values on the rise.

It's Time to Plant!



According to Certified Nursery Professional, Rod Smith, fall is an ideal time to plant. This is a good time to plant bulbs, seeds, and perennials because in the fall the warm soil allows roots to grow faster to establish the plants. And, because the air is cooler, plants don't need as much water.

If you're interested in your flowerbeds looking great during the cold months, aside from evergreen shrubberies, here are some plants that will do well this fall and (possibly) this winter. **Mums** and **anemones** bloom in the fall. **Camellias**, **heathers** and fragrant **daphnes** bloom in the winter. Flowering **kale** and

cabbage are the most colorful in cold weather. Pansies may bloom all fall, winter, and spring in a sheltered place. Also, grass seed is easier to grow in the fall. The warm soil gets grass off to a fast start. Cool, rainy weather keeps it growing with less care.

So, let's get planting!
